The PTA is a group of parents and teachers who work together to organise events to raise funds for school. The teachers and staff always have projects which cannot be covered by local authority funding but would benefit all the children. This year, Sand Hutton PTA has organised a range of events and fund raising activities including a lot of Bingo, a very successful Christmas Fair and a sponsored sports event.

- Christmas Fair, December 2015, raised £1,443
- Sand Hutton Super Heroes Sponsored Event- July, raised £1,008
- Bingo! October 2015 and May 2016, raised £481
- Bags 2 School, October 2015 and April 2016, raised £342
- Bag Packing at Sainsburys with Warthill, October 2015 raised £204
- Summer BBQ - June 2016, raised £197
- Film Night, February 2016, raised £180
- Other Things including 50:50 club, throughout the year, raised £585
